Holiday Activity Fund



Derbyshire's Holiday Activity and Food programme is ready to kick start the summer.

'It's About Me' provides children aged between four and 16 - who are eligible for benefits related free school meals - free spaces at holiday clubs across the county.

The summer 2024 holiday clubs will take place until **Tuesday 3rd September.** Excluding bank holidays and weekends.

- 77 organisations are delivering 167 holiday clubs
- Nearly 60,000 are spaces available across the summer for eligible families

- Activities include sports and games, arts and crafts, cookery, bushcraft, dance and music.
- Families can still book holiday clubs via the HAF website
- All eligible families will need a HAF or IAM code to book a place.
