An Opportunity to Get Involved - East Midlands Fertility Policy Review

Over the next 2 months NHS Derby and Derbyshire Integrated Care Board will be engaging with residents of the East Midlands region, to give them the opportunity to feedback on suggested proposals for an East Midlands Fertility Policy. A 'Fertility Policy' outlines the treatment an individual can receive from the NHS in the area they live in if they are struggling to get pregnant.

At the moment, there are differences in Fertility Policies across the East Midlands Region (which includes Derby and Derbyshire) these differences relate to things such as a person's age, their BMI (a calculation to determine if someone's weight is healthy, e.g. someone might be under or over weight) and the number of cycles of NHS funded treatment available. There are also different access criteria for same-sex couples, those with children from previous relationships, and single individuals.

This review of fertility treatment, suggests that NHS Derby and Derbyshire Integrated Care Board should create a shared Fertility Policy for the East Midlands region, this will mean that everyone gets access to Fertility treatment using the same criteria. The proposed changes are detailed on pages 5 – 7 of the '<u>Case for Change'</u> document.

The feedback gathered from this engagement will be collated and fed into the development of the final East Midlands Fertility Policy. To find out how feedback has influenced the policy keep an eye out for updates on the <u>Online Engagement Platform</u>.
