Bin changes for businesses

From 31st March 2025, all workplaces with 10 or more full-time employees will be required to separate their waste into three different categories under the new Simpler Recycling legislation (micro-firms with less than 10 full-time employees should ensure they comply by 31st March 2027).

The new rules are being introduced to make recycling your waste simpler and consistent across all areas of England, which will contribute to reaching the recycling target of 65%, set by DEFRA.
