Your Journey - sexual violence - a survivor's guide to support and reporting in Derbyshire

We are delighted to announce that "Your Journey – sexual violence a survivor's guide to support and reporting" has now been launched in Derbyshire.

First launched in February 2020, *Your Journey* was written by Nottingham based Consent Coalition, with input from survivors. It gently looks at the decisions a person might make following an incident of sexual violence. This includes sections on:

- Specialist support services
- Decisions, choices and options
- Myth busting
- Independent Sexual Violence Advisors (ISVA)
- Reporting to the Police
- Sexual Assault Referral Centre (SARC)
- Police investigations
- Criminal justice process

The Derbyshire guide can be viewed, downloaded as a pdf and printed from the Consent Coalition website Support Information Adults | Consent Coalition or from the Derbyshire Victim Services website Rape and Sexual Assault | Derbyshire Victim Services which includes a flipbook version.

This makes it easy to find and access by all people, including survivors, their supporters and professionals.
