Putting communities at the heart of local government re-organisation

The leaders of the eight borough and district councils in Derbyshire, together with the leader of Derby City Council, have set out their initial plans to create two unitary councils to cover the county – one in the north, and one in the south.

£200 Fixed Penalty Paid for Abandoning Vehicle in Pilsley

We have issued a £200 fixed penalty notice for the offence of abandoning a vehicle in the district.

Following a report in January 2025, a council officer attended the vehicle in Pilsley and it was found to be untaxed and insecure.

A notice was placed on the vehicle requiring its removal within 7 days but was not complied with, and therefore was removed at cost to the Council.
