Power to Change – Community Business Bright Ideas Fund – Deadline: 9th April 2019

A total of £3,000,000 is being made available over the next three years with grants of up to **£15,000** for a package of tailored support and grants to incorporated or unincorporated organisations in England that want to develop their budding community business ideas.

Successful organisations will receive:

- Business development support – up to 12 days of business development support from Locality, Plunkett Foundation, or Co-operatives UK.
- Grant funding - the opportunity to apply for a grant of up to **£15,000**, which can be spent on specific activities to develop the community business idea.
- Learning and peer networking – access to online resources, thematic webinars and the opportunity to visit and learn from existing community businesses.

The following is an indication of the range of grants available:

- Ideas stage – grants of between **£1,000** and **£10,000**.
- Pre-venture stage – grants of between **£1,000** and **£15,000**.

The Hospital Saturday Fund – Deadline: 3rd April 2019

One off grants up to **£10,000** from The Hospital Saturday Fund whose aims are to provide assistance through its charitable funds for registered health charities such as hospitals, hospices, medical organisations who are in need of grants for medical projects, care, research or support of medical training.

Allen Lane Foundation – Social Cohesion Programme

The Social Cohesion Programme is intended for community-led grassroots groups and organisations in the UK whose work is focused at a 'very local/community level' such as a housing estate or distinct community. Groups whose work solely benefits people within Greater London may not apply unless their work benefits people across a much wider area, then they may be considered.

The programme aims to:

- Proactively work towards building better community cohesion and trust, and encouraging respect and understanding in the local area
- Proactively promote the inclusion of marginalised groups and individuals in the life of the local community

- Fund work which breaks down barriers and tensions in the local community thereby reducing feelings of division and “them and us”.

Viridor Credits - Small Grants Scheme – Deadline: 30th April 2019

The Small Grants Scheme is for Community, Heritage and Biodiversity projects that require up to **£20,000** from Viridor Credits. Includes ERF areas and Pennon Environmental Fund. The project must be site-specific and located within 10 miles of an active Viridor landfill site or an Energy Recovery Facility in England and Wales. The Clothworkers Foundation

The Clothworkers Foundation aims through its funding to improve the quality of life, particularly for people and communities facing disadvantage such as; disabled people, older people, disadvantaged young people, homeless people and more. There is no maximum grant for their main grants scheme while their small grants scheme is **£10,000** max. Their one-off grants are for the purchase of specific and pre-determined capital item(s) for a particular project.

One Stop - Carriers for Causes

Money raised from the 5p carrier bag charge at One Stop stores is being used for a new grant programme 'Carriers for Causes' for local community projects. Grants of up to **£1,000** are available to non-profit organisations and other groups including clubs, schools, parish / town councils, local authorities, housing organisations, CICs etc...

Applicant projects must be within two miles of a One Stop store and demonstrate community need. One Stop stores can be found in locations across Derbyshire including Buxton, Chesterfield, Denby, Derby, Eckington, Heanor, Ilkeston, Matlock, Swadlincote etc...
