### **Help the Homeless – Deadline: 15<sup>th</sup> June**

The charity offers funding four times a year to small and medium-sized registered charities with a turnover of less than £1 million per year. Applications will only be considered from registered charities. All applications must relate to projects that assist individuals in their return to mainstream society, rather than simply offer shelter or other forms of sustenance.

The funding is primarily for capital costs. It cannot be used for computers and IT equipment.

Previously awarded projects include:

- The charity Spear, which works with homeless people in and around Richmond, received a grant to help buy wardrobes for the hostel that they operate.
- The Cathedral Archer Project, a day centre that supports the homeless and vulnerable in Sheffield, received a grant to buy shelving and storage to help them sort food and make food parcels more efficiently.

### **Tesco Bags of Help Grants Programme**

Following a public vote, three projects in each of the 200 Tesco regions will receive a grant each month:

First place - Up to **£5,000**.

Second place - Up to **£2,000**.

Third place - Up to **£1,000**.

The Bags of Help Grants Programme is funded by Tesco customers from the proceeds of the 5p charge for plastic carrier bags as a result of a Government carrier bag levy which was introduced in England on 5 October 2015 and already in place in Scotland and Wales. The programme is managed by Groundwork, an environmental charity, in England and Wales and in partnership with greenspace Scotland in Scotland.

The funding is intended for not-for-profit organisations with projects that deliver physical environmental improvement and encourage the use and long-term sustainability of outdoor spaces.

You can apply for up to **£20,000**. The second round is now open.
