2 Sessional Youth Workers – Fixed Contract for 1 year

The main purpose of the project is to address the following issues:

- **Cultivate a sense of belonging**
- **Support Young people with poor emotional health**
- **Support Children in Care/Care Leavers**
- **Engage with asylum-seeking young people**
- **Engage with young people who are not in Education, Employment or Training (NEET)**

The youth workers will create an informal but safe environment for young people from the BME communities to come together where they can confidently explore and discuss issues without feeling judged.

The workers will work with the following communities:

- **Indian & Bangladeshi**
- **Pakistani**
- **Polish & Eastern European**
- **Filipino**
- **Chinese**
- **Syrian**

Youth Worker (Lead) £2,520 per annum

Hours – Minimum of 26 sessions per annum (approx. 3 hrs) with young people

The sessions will be on Saturday afternoon.

To lead on work with young people from the age of 11 to 19 and to 25 with disabilities and special needs from the Black & Minority Ethnic (BME) Communities in Derbyshire, predominantly in Chesterfield & North East Derbyshire.

The worker will be qualified (Diploma in Community & Youth to NVQ level 2/3), have a current DBS check and preferably be from a BME community or have extensive experience & insight of working within these communities.

Youth Worker (Support) £1,134 per annum

Minimum of 26 sessions per annum (approx.3 hrs) with young people

The sessions will be on Saturday afternoon.

To work with young people from the age of 11 to 19 and to 25 with disabilities and special needs from the Black & Minority Ethnic (BME) Communities in Derbyshire, predominantly in Chesterfield & North East Derbyshire.
